

# **Al-Falah Islamic School | Disciplinary Policy 2024-2025**

Respected Parent/Guardian,

Assalāmu 'Alaikum wa Rahmatullāhi wa Barakātuh

All praise is to Allāh Ta'ālā who has blessed us with Islām and Imān. May peace and salutations be in abundance upon our beloved Nabi ﷺ.

We hope and pray that the students of the Evening/Weekend School will abide by the Code of Conduct of the Al-Falah Islamic School. However, it is our duty as the faculty and administration to ensure that discipline is maintained within the classroom and during Salāh. In the unfortunate event that we need to reprimand and discipline a student due to misbehaviour and/or breach of *Section 12 of the School Act*, we will resort to the following methods of discipline:

- Verbal warning to the student
- Secondary verbal warning to the student with a reminder of the consequences of repeated misbehaviour
- In-class suspension (time-out) and/or lines
- Note to parent(s)
- Call to parent(s)
- Student conference with administration and faculty
- Student conference with parent(s), administration and faculty
- Out-of-class suspension
- Expulsion

## **Section 12 of the School Act**

The Al-Falah Islamic School administration & faculty expect that students behave in accordance with Section 12 of the *School Act*. Section 12 states that students will conduct themselves so as to reasonably comply with the following Code of Conduct:

- Be diligent in pursuing the student's studies;
- Attend school regularly and punctually;
- Cooperate fully with everyone authorized by the Board to provide education programs and other services;
- Comply with the rules of the school;
- Account to the student's teachers for the student's conduct;
- Respect the rights of others;
- Ensure the student's conduct contributes to a welcoming, caring, respectful and safe learning environment that respects diversity and fosters a sense of belonging;
- Refrain from, report and not tolerate bullying or bullying behaviour directed toward others in the school, whether or not it occurs within the school building, during the school day or by electronic means; and
- Positively contribute to the student's school and community.
